













Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program Device Specifications and Requirements

Current as of November 2023

  	<p style="text-align: center;">Operating System</p>	<p>The current version of Windows 10/11 OR MacOS.</p> <p>Android, Chromebooks, Linux, or iOS are NOT permitted under BYOD due to limitations with software capability for classroom use.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Form Factor</p>	<p>A Laptop OR a 2 in 1 convertible device.</p> <p>All devices must have a physical keyboard.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Dimensions</p>	<p>Minimum Screen Size: 11.6".</p> <p>Whilst a touch screen is optional, it is highly recommended.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Battery Life</p>	<p>A minimum of 6 hours of battery life to last the school day.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">RAM</p>	<p>Minimum: 8GB RAM. Recommended: 16GB RAM or higher.</p> <p>Students completing TAS or VA elective subjects should consider 16GB or higher to utilise their specialised software.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Storage</p>	<p>Minimum: 128GB Storage. Recommended: 256GB SSD Storage or higher.</p> <p>A Solid State Drive (SSD) for storage is preferred over a Hard Disk Drive (HDD) due to its performance and capabilities.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Processor</p>	<p>Minimum: Intel i5 or higher, AMD Ryzen 5 or higher or M1 or higher for Macs.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Wireless</p>	<p>Devices must support WiFi 5 or above</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Protection</p>	<p>Tough and sturdy to avoid breakage. Recommended: neoprene protective sleeve with reinforcement or hard case</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Insurance and Warranty</p>	<p>Be aware of the terms of insurance policies/warranties for the device. The school will not accept responsibility for loss or breakage. Some home insurance policies may cover accidental damage – please check with your insurance company.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Software</p>	<p>The Department of Education provides Google Workspace, Adobe Creative Cloud and Office 365 free of charge.</p>
