<i>Baby Shark Tank</i>	Mr. Quinn	What is involved with creating, marketing and selling a product at a market?
<i>What's the Story?</i>	Mr. Schoffl	Creating the different historical strata for their own archaeological site which will involve making all the artefacts that go into each layer based on their research of an ancient civilisation- e.g. papyrus scroll, clay pots, jewellery piece, weapons, religious artefact.
<i>Don't Panic</i>	Ms. Wilk	How can we most effectively and efficiently solve problems as a team?

<i>Mountain Biking 101</i>	Ms. Holmes	Would you like to become a more confident and capable mountain bike rider?  Welcome to MTB 101! Learn all about the sport that is experiencing phenomenal growth in Australia. Basic skills, skill development, bike safety, bike maintenance, optimum nutrition, social fitness networking, training options, and trail locations are just some of the topics you will explore throughout this course. <i>The Best Place In The World</i>	Mr. Mottershead	What is the Favourite place you would like to go to in all The World? Why is this place so special and so interesting to you?
<i>From Little Things Big Things Grow</i>	Ms. Wilmott	How can we create public spaces for our community to enjoy and be environmentally conscious? Develop your design and spatial skills by building a 3D model. Also include excursion to the Edogawa Commemorative Gardens in East Gosford

<i>Pay It Forward</i>	Ms. Jansons	Can we increase happiness by paying it forward?
<i>Yes!!!Your clothes can be reinvented</i>	Ms. Adamski	Can you help minimise the world's landfill problems by giving your clothes a new lease on life? Students will visit a local Charity store and research the world's textile waste. After choosing/buying some donated textile pieces to work with, they will design and make a new refashioned/upcycled piece. The designs are only limited by your imagination.
<i>You Wanna Be A Champion</i>	Mr. Saisell	What does it take to be a champion? Students will gain a greater knowledge and understanding about what it takes to be successful in their chosen sport. They will develop a portfolio that will outline strategies, techniques, tools, and recipes etc. that they can use in their pursuit of sporting excellence.
<i>Nature Calls</i>	Mr. Joyce	Students will investigate prominent natural features of the Central Coast. They will learn how these features were formed through geomorphic processes and will produce promotional resources based on these features. The use of virtual reality tours, posters, 3D modelling, TV adverts and radio adverts will form the promotional side of the Masterclass.
