

A number of students have already begun the process of withdrawing from courses to reduce their pattern of study from 12 units to 10 units. This can only take place with a signed parent note indicating they are aware of course changes. Year 11 yearly reports should be available and out to students during week 6.

Year 10 are busy finalising course work and revision for the School Certificate that commences on Monday 8th November. All Year 10 families should have received a letter explaining exam times, student expectations and times when students need to be at school for their computer exam. Normal classes commence on Friday 12th. During weeks 6-9 Year 10 will be involved in a series of preparation for the senior school programs and also school to work transition programs. This is an excellent opportunity for students to be involved in work experience and I ask students to make contact with Mrs Pursehouse if they are interested. Year 10 graduation will be held on Monday 13th December with School Certificate portfolios and reports going out to all students.

A reminder to Year 10 students who believe they have full time work and/or apprenticeship lined up for 2011 they may request an exemption from school with a signed note from parents and a letter from the employer (letterhead required). Exemptions from school to commence holiday work are available from Monday 6th December when the Year 10 Gold Coast excursion is taking place.

Many of our junior students have been busy over the last few weeks providing assistance to staff in the running of study plus programs for Year 6 students from our partner schools and assisting our Year 7 2011 year advisors with school visits to provide transition information. I would like to thank all students and staff involved in these activities for their time and fantastic presentations. Well done!

### OUR SCHOOL SELECTED TO PARTICITPATE IN IMPORTANT MATHS AND SCIENCE STUDY

Erina High School has been selected to participate in the *Trends in International Mathematics* and *Science Study* (TIMSS). This is an important educational research project investigating student achievements in mathematics and science. More than 60 countries are participating in this study. TIMSS is an important activity to keep us, as parents and citizens, informed about how our students in Australia are performing in comparison to their peers in other countries and to compare programs of study and teaching practices. We will be able to obtain current national and international information which will help improve the teaching and learning of mathematics and science in our country.

Selected students will do an assessment in mathematics and science and complete a questionnaire about their experiences at home and school. There is no need for students to study specifically for assessment as it will not affect individual students' grades or progress in school. All data will be kept strictly confidential and no individual student or school will be identified in published data or reports.

**STUDY PLUS** - Year 6 students from Woodport Public School took part in Study Plus this week with students learning about strategy games from Mr Whatson. Mr McMaster also gave them a taste of Algebra which students were eager to experience.

#### **ATTENDANCE**
